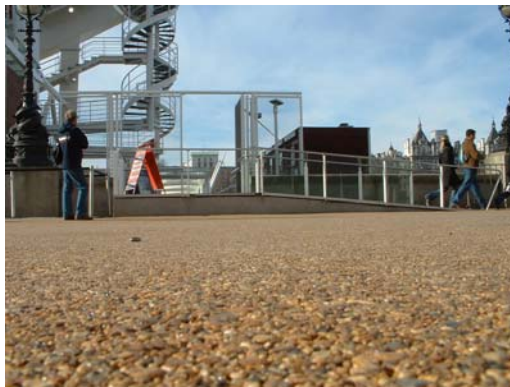


# Clearmac®

### Why Clearmac®

Clearmac® paving was specified by architects and joint owner of the BA London Eye, Marks Barfield, due to its impressive appearance and performance at the Riverwalk on the Southbank, where 4,000m<sup>2</sup> of the material was installed in July 2001.

Clearmac® was laid directly adjacent to the entrance/exit to the London Eye in two twenty-four hour periods, by Ayton Contracting, on behalf of main contractor McNicholas plc. The area had to be carefully managed so as to maintain pedestrian and emergency vehicle access.

The natural gravel appearance of the Clearmac® surfacing complemented the neighbouring architecture and formed an ideal integrated solution with adjacent granite setts and block paving.
