Why Clearmac®

As part of the improvements to the Trafalgar Square area the surfacing around a water feature used as a pedestrian area was due to be replaced with a surface with a high quality finish.

A resin bound surfacing was required to be laid in an area surrounded by polished stone paving blocks, which were set out in a complex pattern. As Clearmac® cold-applied paving is hand laid and compacted, the risk of damage to the paving blocks was eliminated, whereas a hot applied system requires a dead weight roller to compact the surface risking damage to the paving blocks.

Clearmac® had previously been used on a similar scheme with the same contractor for the Riverside Walk on the South Bank in London.
