Minimal disruption for busy market

The installation of more than nine hundred square metres of **Ayton Products'** Tripave[®] rapid curing, waterproof and decorative surface treatment has just been completed to upgrade Norwich Market.

Since it was imperative that sections of the market had to be kept open whilst others were being treated, Tripave[®] was applied in three phases over a nine month period, thus creating little disruption to the market's day-to-day operational activity. The market enhancement project (contract value £54,000) included the installation of both grey and orange colours specifically to demarcate areas of archaeological interest on the site, in this case the Market Cross, which was destroyed in the 1700s.

Tripave[®] is a rapid curing, decorative, impervious and extremely durable surfacing for pedestrian and vehicle trafficked locations. Its use is particularly relevant where time-critical installation is a high priority.

The material is based on technically advanced methyl methacrylate (MMA) resin technology. MMA resins are 100% solids and contain no solvent. The fully bound system, incorporating aggregate within a thin multi-layer system, is compatible with most sub-bases including concrete, asphalt, macadam and metal. It can be overlaid directly onto existing surfaces without the need for breaking out, or for extensive preparation, thus delivering a cost effective, yet highly durable finish.

The tough and durable surface was specified for the prestigious Norwich Market refurbishment scheme by LSI Architects. The base course was prepared by May Gurney Ltd with Tripave being applied by Ayton Products contractors. Main contractor for the scheme was John Youngs.
