## ***TRUST FUNDS CREATE NEW MEMORIAL GARDEN***

Thanks to funds donated by the Ivy Child Trust, set up by the trustees of the late Ivy Child, the Norfolk and Norwich Hospital, its patients and visitors have become the beneficiaries of an attractive, secluded and peaceful memorial garden, specifically constructed to provide an area of contemplation and relaxation.

The new 58 square metre recreational facility, encircled by boxed hedging, plants and trees, has been part surfaced with and enhanced by Clearmac<sup>®</sup>, the UK's premier encapsulated resin bound paving system, manufactured by Norwich based **Ayton Products**. The project is soon to be concluded with the addition of attractive curved stainless steel and hardwood seating.

The wearing course is applied by hand and designed to provide high performance on surfaces subject to point loading such as driveways and parking areas, pedestrian areas, pathways, precincts and lightly trafficked roadways. The cured material gives a textured finish able to resist degradation caused by weathering and UV radiation, oil, fuel and some commonly used solvents.

Architectural, design work, project management and planting for the memorial garden project was all carried out by Plan to Garden. The base course was prepared by May Gurney Ltd and Clearmac<sup>®</sup> was applied by Ayton Products own technicians.

Clearmac<sup>®</sup> installation is carried out throughout the UK and Eire by Ayton Product's network of licensed contractors.
